A BRIEF HISTORY OF LITTLE N.H.L. IN ONTARIO

The Little N.H.L. was started in Georgetown, Ontario, in 1936 with a total of 90 boys registered on 6 teams.

From the outset Little N.H.L. proved an outstanding success in many ways. First, every boy who wished to play hockey in the required age groups had an opportunity of playing organized hockey. Secondly, the parents and school authorities looked with favour on a league which laid such stress on the importance of school work and of good sportsmanship as embodied in the Player's Contract.


From Georgetown, Little N.H.L. spread to Copper Cliff and then rapidly throughout the province. Farm team systems were set up as follows: ages 8 and 9 — Junior; ages 10 and 11 — American League and ages 12 and 13 — N.H.L.

The response was so overwhelming that the Rural Little N.H.L. was organized to provide hockey for boys in the smaller rural centres. District playdowns are held and the winners come together during the Easter Holidays for the All-Ontario Championship Finals.

Bob Goldham, Detroit Red Wings, was the first graduate of Little N.H.L. Other Little N.H.L. graduates who made the N.H.L. are Ted Sloan, Chicago Black Hawks, Jerry Toppazzini, Boston Bruins, Tim Horton, Bob Pulford and George Armstrong, Toronto Maple Leafs.

PLAYING RULES & REGULATIONS

1. LENGTH OF GAMES

(a) JUNIOR "A" AND AMERICAN HOCKEY LEAGUE 2 - 20 minute periods

Last 3 minutes of game stop time

(b) N.H.L. LEAGUE

3 - 15 minute periods Last 3 minutes of game stop time.

2. OVERTIME

- (a) Sudden death stop time up to 10 minutes with change of ends after 5 minutes of play.
- (b) If still tied C.A.H.A. penalty shot system to be used as follows:
- 1 Teams each choose 3 men.
- 2 Teams toss to see who starts.
- 3 Players shoot alternately on goal.
- 4 When all six men have shot, scores are totalled.
- If still tied after six men have shot. Same six men continue shooting one at a time alternately. The score totalled after each pair have shot until such time as the tie is broken.

3. PENALTIES

- (a) All penalties to be stop time, beginning when puck is dropped after infraction is called.
- (b) Fighting or language misconduct, call for automatic banishment from game of the offending player. Team must play shorthanded for the five minute major penalty. This rule applies to goalkeepers as well as other players.
- (c) Body checking in the centre ice area will call for a penalty in all series.
- (d) Deliberate boarding, charging, highsticking, and slashing will incur a major penalty.

4. SIGNING OF PLAYERS

All players, coaches and managers should be in dressing room for signing of all players of team and officials, at least 15 minutes before each game. Late arrival for signing players may result in starting a game late and a team delaying start of a game may be disqualified from further competition in tournament.


