COBOURG FIGURE SKATING CLUB & COMMUNI

The Cobourg Figure Skating Club has become an important part of the community during the few years which have elapsed since the formation of the Club. It was just over eight years ago that a few energetic-minded skating fans got together and established the Cobourg Figure Skating Club, During that time the club has grown until it now exerts an effective impact upon community life, while the membership is open to all ages, the emphasis has been, and will continue to be, on the young people.

The value of figure skating in building strong. healthy bodies is a recognized fact. There have been many instances in which physically - handicapped people have developed into normal beings through the exercise obtained from figure skating. Needless to say, figure skating also benefits those who are not physically-handicapped. It improves timing, co-ordination of mind and muscle and provides grace and poise. It also demonstrates both competitive play and teamwork. For the perfectionist, no sport holds greater incentive.


Those responsible for the progress of the Club have kept in mind that the costs must be kept within the family budget if the Club is to maintain an adequate membership. This has not been easy but the unselfish efforts of the workers have combined to operate the Club satisfactorily. However, there must be a continued growth in membership and there must also be sufficient returns from ticket sales to the annual Skating Carnival if a proper financial balance is to be maintained.

Membership in the Cobourg Figure Skating Club includes three forms of skating instruction ---School Figures, Dancing and Free Skating. Members may skate three times a week and instruction concists of tracings on a figure-eight, either forwards or backwards and on either foot. Also the beginner starts dancing by learning the simplest Dutch Waltz and as proficiency grows, other variations of figure skating and dancing are taught and tests are held twice yearly. Much of the credit for the programme arranged for the Carnival goes to John Rodway, Club Professional and the progress made, from the youngest novice to the most accomplished performer, is a tribute to John Rodway's outstanding ability as an instructor.

Working behind the scenes, making costumes, and doing the many other things which come within the orbit of their activity, are the mothers. Bless 'em. Without them, the Club just couldn't put on a d. Nobody except the mothers and the Club ve, knows how much time and sacrifice has to the making of those lovely costumes which e at this carnival.




