

I know this is for the sports recognition but over the years my parents have volunteered for almost everything happening in the community. They wanted to make Grafton a better place. My mom used to ask my dad if they could just go to an event instead of always running them.

I am breaking this down to point form but would be happy to include some more back ground if needed.

Dad started coaching a team in the CCHL before he could drive in 1962.

Involved in getting the Wintario Grant for the New Arena in Grafton in the Mid 70's. Not to mention all the hours spent painting to save the Township money.

40 years of the Grafton Fastball Tournament (Don Conway has all details)

Along with the tournament went with the fundraising and the man hours to build 5 ball diamonds, all the backstops, the scoreboard, fencing the diamonds, the playground, score keepers benches, basically everything you see at Grafton. Including the original outdoor canteen that no longer exists.

In the early years dad actually played ball, hockey and football. Later years it was too difficult to run these events and play.

They took part in fundraisers such as Walk-A-Thon, Country 105 Dances, Casino Nights, bingos, Hockey Tournaments such as the "men's breakfast tournament"

My mom was there every step of the way. Prime example when it came to all the phone calling it was her. I remember always dad saying "Ann can you call so and so" and my mom respond what is wrong with your father. But she did it anyway.

They spent most of their quality time helping the community and they loved it despite being beat tired most nights. They both worked full time and found time to give their free time to others.
