Lacrosse was originally by the North American Indians. It is the oldest known athletic contest on the North American continent and one of the oldest organized games in the world. It is highly probable that it was played as a formalized pastime by the Indians as far back as an Indian Tribe is known to have been by the Indians.

We are told by Collis, an early explorer and writer, who wrote several interesting descriptions of games he had witnessed over 100 years ago, that the game was a fiery, unbridled exhibition common on the North American Indians. The first European to visit and observe it was a cleric of three thousand miles, playing the early form of the present lacrosse in a way that proved it to be well established. The Indians called the game "hagaxony" meaning ball game. Collis named it "ball play", and early French explorers called it "La Crosse" because the sticks the Indians used in the early days resembled a clergy's crozier.

Here is How To Watch A Lacrosse Game

Is this your first lacrosse game?

If it is, let an oldtime give you a few pointers on how to watch it.

Lacrosse, as might say briefly, is a dynamic game -- total teamwork, fast reflexes and a gentleman. They are all intent on one thing, getting the ball in the other fellow's net and, returning their opponents as early as possible if possible. As in any other game, the first rule is -- watch the ball! In lacrosse the ball is rather small, but has more bounce than a baseball, being made from your Indian Rubber. The ball is wild, heavy, has an astonishing bounce and is yanked with lightning speed by the players. Sometimes it bounces into a spectator's lap or into someone's mouth. If it is enough, in that case, we just get another ball and continue the game.

The floor is divided into three areas, defined as Centre Zone, Defensive Zone and Attacking Zone. One club's Defensive Zone is their opponent's Attacking Zone.

Just there are two fellows in striped shirts who actually do not play in the game, but do a lot of running and clearing activities. These "referees" run the game and see to it that everything is done fairly between the two teams.

Lacrosse is so fast and exciting that all you will remember about the first game is a blur, and your main thought the chap next to you probably was "is the nice white shooting for his brother's team. By your second game you will have a favorite team, and, by your third game you will be picking the chap next to you in the line.

WHAT THEY DO

GOALKEEPER - The goalkeeper's main responsibility is to keep the ball from entering the goal and there are no restrictions placed on the methods he can employ. His offensive contributions are limited and consist of passing the ball up to his teammates or forwards to start a rush. A goalkeeper never kicks a goal and only in rare occasions does he receive credit for an assist.

DEFENDERS - Basically the only difference between the attacking play and their own team (i.e. They also block shots, clear the ball from in front of their goal and watch the opposing forwards. Offensively they carry the ball up the field or pass the ball up to the forwards, then follow play into the attacking zone and help to keep it there.

CENTER - The center operates exactly as just down the middle of the field and usually leads his team's attack by carrying the ball. He sets up play by exchanging passes with his two wingmen and tries to steer the play to create the opponent's goal. Occasionally he tries to keep the play in the attacking zone by heading the opponent's ball center. (Interchanging) After the opposition kicks the ball out of their end of the field he tries to interrupt their playmaking as it moves through the central zone and into the defending zone. (Blockheading).

WING - The two wings move up and down the side of the field with the direction of play. Offensively they set almost all of the corner exchanging passes with two while protecting themselves for a shot on the goal. Defensively they watch the opponents wings and try to disrupt their playmaking and steering in the widest areas back towards the defending zone. (Blockheading).
